

Third Pay October 3

We let these words of Father Palau echo within us:

"I have allowed myself to be seen by you, and you have seen me in the way that is possible in your human condition, so that you may reveal my beauty to the children of men." MR 8,38

"Oh my Spouse, you are beautiful, you are loveable! And are you my Beloved, the object who ravishes my heart? You are worthy of love! Happy the one who comes to know you! Happy, oh Holy Church, the one who becomes united to you in faith, hope and love! In faith, happy the one who believes in you, because he sees you and knows you!" MR 18,4

Scripture Text: Rev. 21: 2-5

And I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "See, the home of God is among mortals.

He will dwell with them;

they will be his peoples,[c]

and God himself will be with them;[d]

he will wipe every tear from their eyes.

Death will be no more;

mourning and crying and pain will be no more,

for the first things have passed away."

And the one who was seated on the throne said, "See, I am making all things new." Also he said, "Write this, for these words are trustworthy and true."

Often beauty is presented to us in well-worn stereotypes, on fashionable catwalks. In the passage from Palau in Mis Relaciones which we have just shared, we see a man who admires beauty, who rejoices in a Beauty that is reflected in you, in me, in all of Creation. This beauty is given us in promise and hope in the words of the Book of Revelation, we are assured that they are "trustworthy and true."

For further reflection: How can I be a reflection of that well-loved Beauty that Palau tells us about?

Let us call to our mind and heart: Human trafficking.

We pray together:

"I always see you [the Church] anew, and the more I look at you the more beautiful I find you, the more I love you, the lovelier and more loveable I see you, for me you are so new that every day seems to me as if it is the first day that I see, love and possess you." MR 9,35
